




Every dollar donated through the www.HelpLucashear.org site is matched by CME Inc.

Is my donation tax deductible:

How do I donate in cash:

Record your donation on the site and indicate there who you gave your cash to.

How do I donate with a check:

Record your donation on the site and follow the directions provided.

How do I donate with a credit card:

Record your donation on the site. You will then be taken to a page that explains how to enter your credit card information depending on whether you have a Paypal account or not. You will then be taken to the page where you can enter your credit card information. Your donation will NOT be taken unless you get to that third page and enter your credit card information. This page looks as follows:

Prompt #2: enter the amount you are donating

Prompt #3: Click this button to update the amount

Prompt #4: Enter your information in either area depending on whether you have a Paypal account or not and click the corresponding button.

Can I use my credit card if I live outside the US:

All credit card transactions are processed through Paypal as the money is directly deposited into the Philip Hayden foundation. Unfortunately, Paypal does not support all countries. So, if you are in a country that does appear in the credit card processing page, you will need to donate using cash through someone involved in this effort. You should still record your donation on the site as a cash donation and indicate who you gave the cash to.
